DESCRIPTION

The Old World, the New World, and the terroir. This is the tale of Two Birds. The first comes from New World distant horizons, the second is born in the heart of the Old-World winemaking area. Despite their geographical distance, these Two Birds share one thing in common: their love for outstanding wine and great terroirs.

This tale reflects the story of the head winemaker: after traveling the world gaining experience in South America, South Africa, and Australia, she has now settled back in France to create this range of extraordinarily fruity and approachable wines.

Two Birds One Stone Blanc 2021

Marilyn Lasserre is the winemaker for Two Birds One Stone. She blends Colombard & Uni Blanc grapes from twenty-year-old vines grown in clay-limestone soil. The vineyard is 500 hectares and is 150-200 meters above sea level.

These grapes have been selected in a specific area where the climate is more continental thanks to the influence of the Atlantic Ocean. Two distinct kinds of terroirs are distinguishable, near the coast the soil is sandy, and rainfall is high, whereas the east has warm and dry summers with clay-limestone soils.

Tasting Notes

NOSE:

Light and glossy lemon hue. Delicate aromas of nectarine, grapefruit, and citrus fruits.

PALATE:

Crisp and light-bodied, with a pleasant minerality.

PAIRING:

Enjoy this wine chilled, as an aperitif or with cold cuts, mature cheeses, seafood.
