

# MOULIN DE GASSAC GUILHEM ROSÉ

### DESCRIPTION

Recognized and appreciated in more than 70 countries all over the world, the Moulin de Gassac Plot Selections have expressed our family's philosophy for more than 20 years through a range of enjoyable wines characterized by elegance and freshness. A beautifully refined expression of the Languedoc's generous character.

In the early 1990s, the Guibert family set themselves a new challenge: the creation of a new range of approachable wines in the same Gassac philosophy, leading to the discovery of the exceptional Villeveyrac "amphitheatre" site.

This led to a long and fruitful partnership between Mas de Daumas Gassac and the winegrowers from this terroir. The first wines were produced in 1991, the result of a plot-by-plot selection from thirty local winegrowers. The Moulin de Gassac range was born in 1991, with the Mas de Daumas Gassac's hallmark and Guibert' signature.

For more than 30 years this authentic approach, with daily involvement, has inspired us in an ongoing quest to obtain the best possible quality from these vineyards. Now covering an area of 250 hectares, all the plots are subject to a rigorous set of specifications: terroir-based plots selection, low yields, specific tanks for plots vinifications, 100% of the vineyard run with insect sexual confusion (a bio approach to stop all other treatments). Two agronomists engineers from Mas de Daumas Gassac – in charge of the SAS Moulin de Gassac wines – are present on site throughout the year. They are the guarantee of the respect of the Gassac philosophy and savoir-faire. The grapes are rigorously selected by our team and are therefore harvested at perfect maturity, the winemaking and ageing is managed by us.

Our involvement in the personality of each wine, the low production levels, and our absolute respect for the terroir, make this Moulin de Gassac range of wine a unique opportunity to discover a family of fine balanced wines.

### **Moulin De Gassac Guilhem Rosé**

The rosé is a blend of 35% Syrah, 35% Grenache and 30% Carignan grapes. The grapes were grown in clay and limestone terroir close to the Thau Lagoon. They are 100% de-stemmed, direct pressed, and aged for 5 to 6 months in stainless steel tank.

### **Tasting Notes**

#### **NOSE:**

Lively, vivid rose pink. Some salmon glints. Pleasant, intense, floral with notes of citrus.

#### **PALATE:**

Well balanced and bright with red currants and berries notes. Splendidly fresh and long.

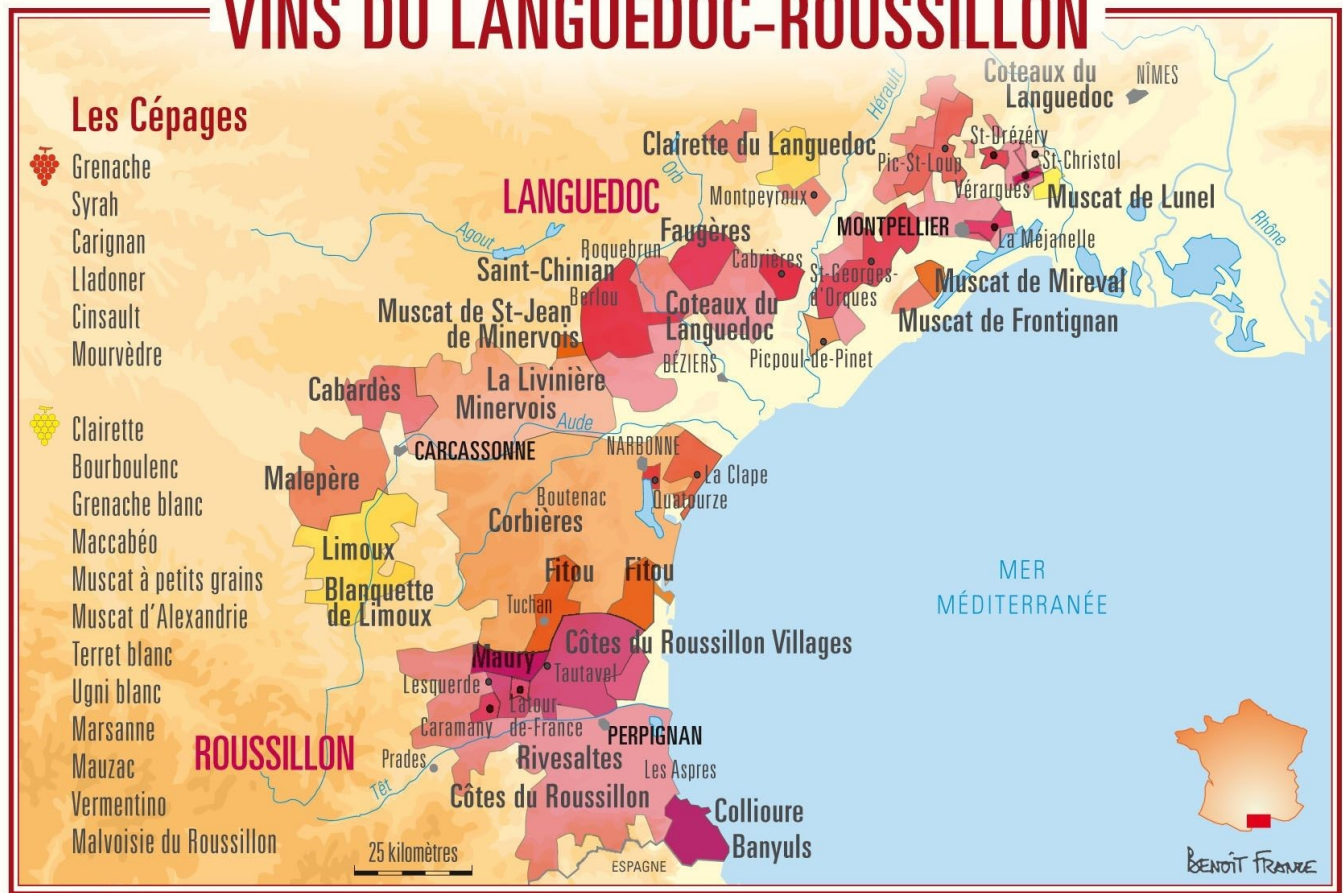
#### **PAIRING:**
