DESCRIPTION

Les Vignobles Foncalieu are a cooperative of winegrowers that produce a magnificent range of terrior wines. Thanks to their meticulous selection of the very best vine plots, the Foncalieu winegrowers have crafted a magnificent range of terrior wines. Their technical teams include international talents who revel in this mosaic of terroirs. Michel Servage and the 1,200 winegrowing estate owners produce upmarket wines of excellent quality. With the help of a group of pioneering winegrowers, Foncalieu has committed to organic agriculture. It is a choice which requires more work and greater investment, to produce lower per-hectare yields. But it is a source of great pride for them to be able to offer consumers wines sprung from soils which are healthier and more alive than ever before.

From the gates of Carcassonne to the shores of the Mediterranean, their terroirs are as unique as they are multiple. Their winemakers are guided by the same vision, to produce exceptional wines while respecting these terroirs, their richness, and the environment.

From the balconies of the Aude, to the limestone soils of the Corbières and the red soils of Saint-Chinian, they cultivate 5,172 hectares of vines on 4 AOPs (Minervois, Saint-Chinian, Corbières, Languedoc) and 4 IGPs (Pays d'Oc, Vallée du Paradis, Coteaux d'Enserune, Cité de Carcassonne).

RESERVE SAINT MARC CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2020

Reserve Saint Marc is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from three different locations: the Puyheric, Languedoc, and Southwest France. The grapes are grown on twenty-five-year-old vines in clay and limestone soils. The harvest is mechanized, all grapes are destemmed, pneumatic

pressing occurs, and 2-week temperature-controlled fermentation happens in stainless steel tanks using select yeast. Daily mechanical punch down is employed to extract tannins and color. The wine is then aged for three months in stainless steel vats.

Tasting Notes

Nose:

Violet color. Aromas and flavors of blackberry jam, licorice, hints of peach, and black tea.

Palate:

A slightly chewy, vibrant, dryish medium body and a smooth, medium-length finish with moderate oak flavor. It is silky in the mouth and delivers fresh and spicy flavors. A juicy red to please the crowd.

Pairing:

Ideal with all red meats and grilled dishes like pot roast, steak & potatoes, and beef stew.
