

ETTORE GALASSO SANT' ELISA PINOT GRIGIO 2022/\$9.99



DESCRIPTION

Coming from northern Italy, the Galasso family has settled in Abruzzo since the late 17th century. The patriarchal family has always worked in the production of extra virgin olive oil, fruit, and grapes. The private winery is located in the village of Loreto Aprutino and is surrounded by the three main national parks of the region. From the 1960s, the family has undergone a complete change in its organization by dividing the business into various sectors.

Ettore Galasso has been in charge of the winery's fortunes since the 1970s. It was he who brought the winery into the modern age and began bottling its own wine instead of selling it in barrels. Always innovative, Ettore Galasso focused early on environmental protection and green energy. Today, for example, the winery is proud to be able to cover its entire production with energy from its own photovoltaic systems.

Today the winery is one of the most important wine producers in the whole of Abruzzo, with its own vineyard area of 120 hectares. The main grape grown is the Montepulciano grape, from which the world-famous Montepulciano d'Abruzzo and the aromatic rosé Cerasuolo are produced.

They control the full process from vineyards to bottle. The large availability of selected grapes, the use of most updated technology in the winery, and the support of highly recognized professionals make Cantine Galasso one of the most significant wine producers in the area. The winery currently produces 3,000,000 bottles per year (from approx 220 ha of which 120 owned vineyards and 100 controlled).

Tasting Notes

Nose:

Sant'Elisa Pinot Grigio delle Venezie is a clean fresh wine of bright straw color with coppery hues. Its complex aroma varies from floral notes of rose and acacia blossom, scents of apricot, and citrus fruit, hints of walnuts, and spices.

Palate:

This medium-light bodied, dry, crisp wine enchants with great minerality, and a generous mouthfeel with a crisp, refreshing feel.

Pairing:

Wine for serving with rice, light pasta dishes, white meat, and fish. It also accompanies cured meats and egg dishes.
